



Decree – Public Notice – Ministry of Customs and Tax
Quarantine and Banned Items Decree, 2012

- 1) All food products must be examined by HM Customs, Tax and Revenue (See section 3). Failure to do so shall result in a \$15 fine.
- 2) Items that are prohibited from entering Innhau
 - Firearms (See section 3) including Nerf guns
 - Slaves
 - Alcohol of any kind
 - Any liquids more than 100mL (see section 3)
 - Tobacco products of any kind
 - Micro- or macronational criminals
 - Really pommy Poms that call you a “chap” all the time
 - Communists
 - Neo-Nazis and
 - Rotten fish
- 3) Excuses for allowing some items listed above:
Firearms – Allowed if containing a letter from the Innhausian Ministry of Defence.

Food and Liquid – Only applying to Bedroomia Palace. If food or water is being bought in for the King if he is sick, it does not need to be examined.
- 4) The consequences, unless stated, is a \$20 fine.
- 5) This law comes into place on the 13th of July, 2012 at 08:44
